The MAB Foundation Student Loan Repayment Program supports Michigan broadcasters with \$2,000 grants applied directly to qualifying student loan debt.

Quick Facts

Grant Amount

One-time \$2,000 Grants awarded to selected eligible recipients.

Student Loan Repayment

Funds are paid directly to your loan lender or servicer.

Who Can Apply?

Full-time employees of MAB or MAPB member stations working in Michigan.

Application Deadline

October 15, 2026

For decades, the MAB Foundation has invested in the future of Michigan broadcasting through scholarships, internships, and professional development opportunities. The Student Loan Repayment Program extends that commitment by supporting early-career professionals as they establish lasting careers at Michigan's radio and television stations.

Are You Eligible?

You may apply if you meet all of the following criteria:

- Are employed full time by an MAB or MAPB member station.
- Are within 10 years of completing your post-secondary education.
- Have qualifying student loan debt from an accredited college or university.
- Have student loans currently in repayment (or entering repayment).
- Have not received an MAB Foundation Student Loan Repayment Grant within the past three years.

Preference may be given to applicants who graduated from Michigan-based colleges or universities.
